

I. Review of International Calendar:

- a) Review of PAGU Championships Directives to determine what, if any, impact it would have on previously distributed 2015 International Fall Calendar
- b) PAGU Championships will be for age group athletes and any Seniors who would like to attend. There will be limited, if any funding for Seniors for this competition;
- c) Pat Wade Classic will be the required Fall competition for Seniors. Age group may attend Pat Wade;
- d) Once teams are named. International Club Team (ICT) Coordinator will work with coaches to determine which approved meet they will attend: The options are Intl. Tournament Winobranie and (Breda Open or Zwingerpokal). After feedback from the ICT coaches P.C. will approve which competition between Breda and Zwingerpokal will be the approved competition.

II. Dates and Location for Acro Cup (Worlds Selection)

Discussion on whether Acro Cup would be held in conjunction with WOGA Classic. Due to the deadlines for Visa Request letters and time frame for

securing Visas for travel to China, Acro Cup will not be held in conjunction with the 2016 WOGA Classic. P.C. would like to hold future Acro Cups with WOGA Classic.

P.C. discussed options for dates/location for Acro Cup. It was determined that it would need to be held the end of December or early January in order to secure Visas in time for travel to China. Various options were discussed and it was suggested that the Elite Committee be included in the discussion. Marie Annonson, Elite Chair will discuss with her Committee and make a recommendation to the Program Committee.

III. Compulsory Leotards

J.O. Committee Chair, Sarah Thomas put forward the recommendation from the J.O. Committee that we go to compulsory leo's for Levels 5-7 (level 8 one optional/one compulsory). After discussion, the vote was there would not be compulsory leotards for these levels.
