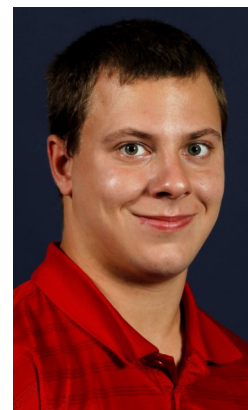
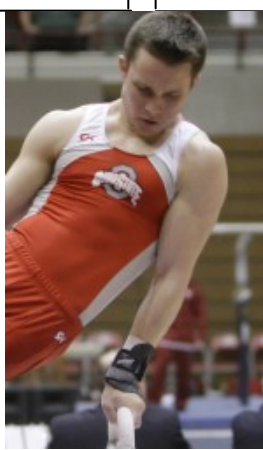


NCAA DIVISION 1 NATIONAL GYMNAST OF THE WEEK
