ALEC ROBIN OF OKLAHOMA MPSF GYMNAST OF THE WEEK

Oklahoma junior **Alec Robin** (Calabasas, CA) finished first on floor (30.900) and 12th in the all-around (165.900) at the Winter Cup last weekend. His scores of 15.500 and 15.400 on floor were the third and fourth best among all scores posted at the event. Robin also placed fifth on pommel horse (27.300) and 14th on vault (29.600) among the best gymnasts in the nation. Robin previously earned an MPSF Gymnast of the Week honor on Feb. 5, 2013.

FIRST-EVER WINTER CUP FINALS FOR AIR FORCE; OU'S ROBIN WINS FLOOR

9 AIR FORCE Nick Gaudlip and Tim Wang became the first Air Force gymnasts to advance to the Winter Cup finals in Las Vegas, NV this past week. Gaudlip finished ninth on high bar with a two-day total of 28.200. He placed third in that event during Thursday's preliminary session after accounting for a season-best 14.350, before adding a score of 13.850 during the event finals. Guadlip also competed on the parallel bars during the finals (13.200). Wang's top finish came on high bar, where he placed 12th (27.900), en route to 16th-place all-around (162.950).
