AKASH MODI OF STANFORD MPSF GYMNAST OF THE WEEK

Stanford freshman Akash Modi (Morganville, NJ) claimed his fourth allaround title of the season and added a win on parallel bars with a 15.800, as the Cardinal recorded a second-best 443.650 at home against No. 10 California and several international squads. Modi scored 15.000 or higher in five of six events and his all-around of 91.350 is the highest in the nation this season and the second-highest of any gymnast in the country since 2008 (when the current scoring system was implemented). He is the only gymnast in the country to surpass 90.000 (and has done it twice this season). This is his MPSF-leading third conference weekly award this year. AIR FORCE SHATTERS ITS ALL-TIME RECORD SCORE

8 AIR FORCE Tim Wang picked up nine first-place finishes as the Falcons defeated Illinois-Chicago twice, including an Academy-record score of 439.700 during their second victory last Sunday. That team overall score was over eight points ahead of the previous-high, as well as the sixth-best in the NCAA this year. Wang tallied four career-high marks, including Academy records on the pommel horse (15.100 on Feb. 28) and all-around (Career-high 88.400 on Mar. 1). He won the floor (14.750), pommel (15.100), parallel bars (14.600), high bar (14.300) and all-around (87.200) during the first win, before adding titles on floor (career-high, 14.950), horse (15.000), vault (14.850) and all-around (88.400) on Sunday. Friday, Air Force totaled 423.800, earning at least a share of every event title.

- **# 2 STANFORD** Akash Modi claimed his fourth all-around title on the season and added a win on parallel bars with a 15.800, as the Cardinal recorded a second-best 443.650 at home against California and several international squads. - **# 10 CALIFORNIA** Kevin Wolting led the Bears in a third-place all-around finish last Saturday at No. 4 Stanford at the Collegiate Cup (87.000). He posted a 15.150 on the floor, equaling his season-best, along with a 14.700 on vault, and 14.500 on high bar.
- **# 1 OKLAHOMA** was off last week, and hosts Nebraska Sunday (Mar. 9). Alec Robin finished first on floor (30.900) and 12th in the all-around (165.900) at the Winter Cup the weekend prior. His scores of 15.500 and 15.400 on floor were the third and fourth best among all scores posted at the event. Robin also placed fifth on pommel horse (27.300) and 14th on vault (29.600) among the best gymnasts in the nation.
