## **BID INFORMATION**

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### **EVENT OVERVIEW**

Gymnastics City USA is a collective of USA Gymnastics' most prestigious events including US Olympic Team Trials – Gymnastics, USA Gymnastics Championships, Gymnastics for All GymFest, and USA Gymnastics National Congress & Tradeshow. In 2028, Gymnastics City USA will be a true celebration of the sport of gymnastics in the lead up to the Los Angeles 2028 Olympic Games.

2028 U.S. Olympic Team Trials for Gymnastics (Trials) will feature the country's top men's and women's artistic gymnasts as they vie for the opportunity to represent the U.S. in the LA 2028 Olympic Games. The men's competition will take place Thursday and Saturday with the women in action Friday and Sunday. The Olympic team will be named at the conclusion of each discipline's second day of competition.

The USA Gymnastics Championships (USA Gym Champs) is a five-day competition involving the top Rhythmic, Acrobatic and Trampoline & Tumbling gymnasts in the United States. This event combines three Development Championships for each of three disciplines with an exciting, combined competition for the senior elite gymnasts of all three disciplines in one arena. Along with crowning national champions we will name the national teams that will be training for World Championship and World Cup assignments as well as the Olympic Team for Rhythmic and Trampoline. There will be approximately 2,000 athletes and an additional 600 coaches, judges and staff coming from around the country to participate.

The USA Gymnastics for All GymFest (GymFest) includes all activities within the Gymnastics for All Discipline and will feature over 800 participants of all ages and abilities. The event will include the TeamGym National Championships, the Acrobatics and Tumbling National Championships, the Gym for Life Challenge, Group Performances and City Performances.

In conjunction with the U.S. Olympic Trials, USA Gymnastics Championships, and GymFest, we will hold an annual National Congress and Trade Show. Upwards of 2,000 gymnastics professionals from around the country come together annually for a three-day educational conference and trade show.

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## TELEVISION

USA Gymnastics in partnership the USOPC will broadcast this competition on network television with its broadcast partner. USA Gymnastics will bear the production costs associated with the broadcast.

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## HOST / PARTNER

Due to the high level of visibility created by this competition, a unique relationship is formed between the host city and USA Gymnastics. A partnership with USA Gymnastics, the USOPC, the city, CVB, sports commission, venue and hotel are necessary for a successful event.

### VENUE SPECIFICATIONS

This event needs three facilities in close proximity to each other and the hotels. In many situations the Competition Arena and Auxiliary Training Venue can be in the same facility. This event will need a modern arena for competition meeting the following specifications:

#### Trials Competition Arena

- Competition Floor Area: 85 ft. wide x 200 ft. long with a minimum 40' ceiling height.
- Additional Floor Space: 2500 sq.ft. on one side and end for production and media
- Spectator seating: 15,000 minimum (18,000+ Preferred)
- LED video and ribbon boards and control room
- Hospitality Area for up to 200 guests
- Auxiliary Rooms: Adequate space for locker rooms, judges' meetings, production office, and catering.
- Television Parking Area: Space for production trucks, generator, uplink, and office trailers.
- Location for a Fan Fest pre and or post event for up to 2000 fans

### USA Gymnastics Championships

The ideal site will have 3 competition venues in convention or event space, with an

attached Arena and hotels within walking distance.

1. Arena: Elite Competition (Acro, Rhythmic, and T&T Elite competition)
  - a. Arena, minimum seating of 6,000
  - b. 100' X 220' clear floor space
  - c. 45' clear height minimum
  - d. 4 meeting rooms
  - e. 2 Athlete only Locker rooms or bathrooms
  - f. 10,000 square foot warm up area adjacent to competition space (30' clear height); if the arena is attached to the Development Program competition venues, this space can serve as the warm-up area)
2. Acrobatic Venue: Development Program Competition
  - a. 40,000 square feet
  - b. Seating for 600 (chair back bleacher style, preferred)
  - c. 27' clear height
3. Rhythmic Venue: Development Program Competition
  - a. 30,000 Square feet
  - b. Seating for 400 (chair back bleacher style, preferred)
  - c. 30' clear height, 40' preferred
4. Trampoline and Tumbling Venue: Development Program Competition
  - a. 60,000 square feet
  - b. Seating for 1,000 (chair back bleacher style, preferred)
  - c. 30' clear height minimum
5. Awards Room space needs to be near Development Program Competition area, to be shared by all three disciplines
  - a. 15,000 Square feet
  - b. Theatre style for a minimum seating of 400
6. Additional space needed near Development Program Competition area, to be shared by all three disciplines
  - a. 2 Rooms theatre style for 200
  - b. 4 Rooms classroom style for 30
  - c. 1 Room for combined registration
  - d. Athlete only, non-public restrooms adjacent to competition floors
  - e. 5,000 square feet for vendors in a common area

  - 2 Meeting Rooms (450 classroom/schoolroom)
  - 3 Meeting Room (450 theater)

  - 5 Meeting Room (225 theater)
  - 5 Breakout Meeting Rooms
- Exhibition Hall:
  - Space minimum of 100,000 square feet
  - Area to conduct registration in close proximity to exhibit hall.
  - Minimum 20 ft. ceiling height
  - One (1) Show Office

- Two (2) move-in days
- One (1) move-out day
- Three (3) operation days
- Ballroom for Hall of Fame Luncheon (600)
- Meeting rooms for pre and post conference meetings

## **GymFest**

- Training Hall size should be at least 90' x 130' with a 25' ceiling (unless otherwise approved by USA Gymnastics). TeamGym Competition Hall size should be at least 90' x 130' with a 25' ceiling and stadium type seating for 1000.
- A&T Competition would need a space of 42'x42' with an extra 20' of space on each side.
- 2 Meeting Rooms – Rooms of varying size accommodating an officials' meeting room and a staff meal room.
- 1 Large Meeting Room space for an awards room to accommodate about 200 people.
- One (1) Show Office
- Two (2) move-in days
- One (1) move-out day
- Three (3) operation days
