

## 2028 Trampoline & Tumbling Elite Challenge

### BID INFORMATION

#### EVENT OVERVIEW

The Elite Challenge includes competitions for Level 10, Open & Elite Trampoline & Tumbling athletes in the following events: individual trampoline, tumbling, double mini-trampoline, and synchronized trampoline. A host city can anticipate a delegation size of approximately 500 people, which includes athletes, coaches, judges, and staff. Athletes often travel with accompanying families (parents and extended family) in addition to the delegation numbers. The competition format includes one day of training and three days of competition.

#### HOST / PARTNER

USA Gymnastics is looking for a partnership with a host city that will help offset venue costs. Host cities would ideally include the following features:

- Proximity to hub airport
- Proximity to a variety of dining options

#### BID PROCEDURE

Interested parties should provide the following information:

- Confirm interest in hosting the event
- Proposed venue with availability for requested dates
- Copy of proposed venue map/layout
- Hotel options with available room block

#### HOTEL

A graduated room block as shown below will be needed with a peak of 60 rooms with 50 doubles and a total of 250 room nights. The room block below would ideally be held at a single

hotel. It is preferred that the hotel block is located within walking distance of the venue. Our travel partner will contract with the hotel directly on behalf of USA Gymnastics and will handle all reservations.

**VENUE SPECIFICATIONS**

The ideal venue is small arena space or event center with fixed seating. Exhibit Hall space with portable seating would also work. Venue should meet the following requirements:

- Competition Floor Area: 85 ft. x 200 ft. or 115 ft. x 150 ft.
- Minimum Ceiling Height: 30 ft.
- Minimum Spectator seating: 750
- Auxiliary Rooms:
  - One (1) officials meeting and meal room, set for up to thirty (30) officials.
  - One (1) stretching & staging area immediately adjacent to the competition floor.
  - Ideally 1000-2000 sq. ft. of space in the lobby, concourse, spectator area or other near the competition hall to accommodate vendors.
