The Men's National Apparatus Leaders (NAL) are six (6) High-Performance positions operating under the guidance of the Men's Program Vice-President, Men's High Performance Director and the Men's Development Program Director. National Apparatus Leaders will also be members of the Men's National Coaches Council (NCC).

Position Summary: National Apparatus Leaders are apparatus experts who are responsible for leading athlete and coach development on their designated apparatus.

### Essential Duties:

- Develop educational content for U.S. coaches and athletes, including lesson plans, videos, presentations, and informational newsletters
- Oversee their designated apparatus at National Team camps and provide feedback to coaches and athletes following trainings
- Collaborate with HP Staff, Data & Analytics Specialists and U.S. judges to align teaching and evaluation of skills and routines
- Provide guidance on High-Performance Plans and initiatives, as required
- Attend National Coaches Council meetings
- Present on their apparatus at National Congress and Men's Coaches Workshops

### General Duties & Responsibilities:

- Demonstrate a clear understanding of USA Gymnastics Mission and Vision.
- Adhere to USA Gymnastics Code of Ethical Conduct & Leadership Eligibility & Service Policy
- Adhere to all Safe Sport regulations, by ensuring that all necessary preventive and protective measures are taken to maximize safety and security.
- Communicate information effectively both verbally and in writing.

### Compensation:

- This is a contracted position to be paid \$5,000 annually.
