A) USAG National Office Reports

- Reviewed previous events (i.e. Development Program Nationals, Junior Pan Am, US Championships, Qualifiers, Olympic Trials, Olympics...)
- Three Charters have been officially approved (MPC, Jr. Selection Committee and Sr. Selection Committee). The MDPC Charter is complete and needs to be approved.
- Development Program Manual was published and is available; Future stars and technical sequences documents have been completed and are available.
- The club track: Social media push centered around Virtual Congress. Will be follow up in the coming months.
- NCAA programs: Two NCAA programs have been officially added and will begin competition in the 2022-2023 season
