C. Qualification Process into East and Western National Championships

The qualification process for Eastern and Western Nationals should be similar.

Motion: Beginning in 2022, each region will use the same qualification procedure into Eastern and Western National Championships, which is a Top-Down method of selecting athletes based on the all-around score regardless of age group. Competitions for one level should be on the same day if possible.

CLARIFICATION: Each Region can determine their own appropriate age divisions at their respective Regional Championships.

D. Awards and Eastern and Western

Motion: Beginning in 2022, at the Eastern and Western National Championships, there will be four equal age divisions for each level. Eight places will be awarded per event and the all-around and will be awarded in each age division for each level.

E. JE Qualifying Scores

Recommendation:

- Lower the JE qualifying scores one point for each level.
- Reduce the total number of petitions. Allow athletes to achieve the score as opposed to petition. Only allow injury and illness petitions.
- Level 8 & 9 are only injury and illness petitions.
- Discussion: Allotment should reflect the talent of the region. Can JE qualification be based on allotment and score?

F. Petition Process

A working group should be created to process petitions. Keep the petition process the same for now. Consider for further review.
