**C. Qualification Process into East and Western National Championships**

The qualification process for Eastern and Western Nationals should be similar.

**Motion: Beginning in 2022, each region will use the same qualification procedure into Eastern and Western National Championships, which is a Top-Down method of selecting athletes based on the all-around score regardless of age group. Competitions for one level should be on the same day if possible.**

**D. Awards and Eastern and Western**

**Motion: Beginning in 2022, at the Eastern and Western National Championships, there will be four equal age divisions for each level. Eight places will be awarded per event and the all-around and will be awarded in each age division for each level.**

**E. JE Qualifying Scores**

Recommendation:

- Lower the JE qualifying scores one point for each level.
- Reduce the total number of petitions. Allow athletes to achieve the score as opposed to petition. Only allow injury and illness petitions.
- Level 8 & 9 are only injury and illness petitions.
- Discussion: Allotment should reflect the talent of the region. Can JE qualification be based on allotment and score?
