I. Additional open spots for 2026 US Championships

The current [US Championships Qualification Procedures](#) for junior athletes, assigns 46 total athletes into the junior Day 1 session. There is room for two additional athletes to bring the number to 48. As there is no set process for adding two more athletes, the suggestion was made to bring two more from the National Qualifier competition. However, at this time, the registration deadline has closed for the Qualifier and the

proposal was not supported to amend the quota spots from this competition after the registration deadline. No additional quota spots will be added for the junior session.

II. Incentivizing junior athletes to compete two Vaults

The MPC had a brief discussion on how to incentivize junior athletes to develop two high level Vaults to be more internationally competitive on this event. The Committee discussed incentives at US Championships, such as requiring two Vaults to be considered in the final Vault rankings. More discussion is needed on this topic.

III. Technical Sequences for Level 10's at Regional Championships

The topic continues to be brought up regarding the need/support for the Level 10 Junior Elite athletes to compete the Technical Sequences at their Regional Championships. The MPC is in support of the continuation of this process, and everyone agreed that no changes would be made in this current Olympic cycle.

The MPC will skip its next scheduled meeting in July and will reconvene at US Championships in August.
