

## Coaches Selection Guidelines Poland World Cup- 2024

1. The coaches for the 2024 World Cups Team must meet the following minimum criteria:
  - Be a current professional member of USA Gymnastics in good standing.
  - Possess a valid passport that does not expire until at least six (6) months after the conclusion of the event.
  - Be in good health and able to withstand the physical rigors of traveling with and working with the team.
  - Be available for the entire duration of the competition, including any mandatory training specified.
  - Have thorough knowledge of FIG rules and regulations.
  - Coaches should be available to assist and support all delegation pair/groups during the training cycle leading into the event.
  
2. Coaches will be selected according to the total number of coaching credentials available, as per the FIG Technical Regulations and Rules for Accreditation, and limited to one (1) coach per pair/group, based on the following criteria in no specific order:
  - Personal Coach of an athlete named to the 2024 World Cup team.
  - Demonstrated ability to establish harmonious working relationships with all athletes and team personnel.
  - Ability to work with other Team USA groupings if/when required.
    - History of performance outcomes coaching various categories (WG, MG, MP, WP, & MXP) of pair/groups at the Sr Elite level.
    - General physical and mental readiness to assist skills at the Sr Elite level.
  - Experience coaching at international competitions, medals won, and history of traveling internationally with athlete(s). **A resume should be submitted by April 19<sup>th</sup>.**
  - Number of years coaching at the Sr Elite level.
  - Ability to work as part of Team USA in terms of respectful and professional communication to athletes, coaches, judges, and other officials.
  - Ability to attend all required meetings, training, and competition sessions.
  - Medal potential of competing pair/groups(s) of personal coaches based on performance/scores from the 2024 Winter Selection and past results.
