Statement of Principles

In 2024, USA Gymnastics will focus efforts and resources into the following international competitions through entering teams and individuals. These competitions have been chosen for reasons including but not limited to timing, competitive fields, ability to safely attend, and international relations.

In order to provide the best chance to selected athletes to achieve their goals, and in order to retain a minimum competitive standard for USA Gymnastics T&T teams, smaller delegations than the maximum may be assigned to a specific event. This will be determined on a case-by-case basis, for reasons including but not limited to allocation of support personnel (medical, coaches, security, HoD etc.), safety considerations, timing of key domestic events, and prioritization of other relevant resources.

General Note for All Events

Where “Senior” and “Senior Elite” are listed in this document, these refer to the USAG division. For Pacific Rim Championships, Pan American Championships, and Indo-Pacific Championships, scores from both divisions at relevant events will be combined for the purposes of ranking and international selection.

Ranking of Athletes (for non-Olympic qualification World Cups and World Cup Invitationals)

Senior Elite (all disciplines)

Athletes will be ranked from each event using their qualification scores at key domestic meets (Winter Classic, Elite Challenge, and USA Gym Champs) and international events (representing USA or otherwise approved) for 12 months prior to selection. For domestic events, scores from both Senior and Intermediate Elite divisions will be combined. More recent and more important competitions will be weighted more heavily. Athletes will receive an overall ranking using the following criteria (in no particular order):

- Head-to-head rankings between US athletes at the same competitions.
- Ranking within US athletes at the past 12 months’ key domestic and international competition (only recorded for completed routines).
- Demonstrated professional attitude, compliance with responsibility manual, and ability to positively contribute to the team dynamic.
- This ranking will be a guide only, and other relevant information may be considered.
- Athletes will be assigned based on overall ranking as it relates to the individual criteria listed for each event.

Junior Elite (all disciplines)

Athletes will be ranked from each event using their qualification scores at key domestic meets (Winter Classic, Elite Challenge, and USA Gym Champs) and international events (representing USA or otherwise approved) for 12 months prior to selection. More recent and more important competitions will be weighted more heavily. Athletes will receive an overall ranking using the following criteria (in no particular order):

- Head-to-head rankings between US athletes at the same competitions.
- Ranking within US athletes at the past 12 months’ key domestic and international competition (only recorded for completed routines).
- Demonstrated professional attitude, compliance with responsibility manual, and ability to positively contribute to the team dynamic.
- This ranking will be a guide only, and other relevant information may be taken into account.
- Athletes will be assigned based on overall ranking as it relates to the individual criteria listed for each event.

Coaches Assignments

Due to the availability of a limited number of coach credentials at all T&T international events, team coaches will be assigned based on the following:

All coaches must meet the following minimum criteria:

- Available for the entire duration of the event, including all mandatory travel, training and competition.

- Compliance with the USA Gymnastics Safe Sport Policy, Code of Ethical Conduct, and Trampoline & Tumbling Responsibilities Manual.
- Current Competitive Coach member in good standing with USA Gymnastics.
- Meet the Qualifications for Service outlined in the USA Gymnastics Leadership Eligibility and Service policy.

Additional criteria to be considered in selecting coaches include (not listed in order of importance):

- International experience
- Proven leadership ability
- Proven ability to communicate effectively with athletes, coaches, and judges
- Rapport with athletes
- Technical knowledge
- Knowledge of FIG rules and Code of Points
- National Team Coordinator or personal coach of an athlete named to the 2024 Indo Pacifics team.

Judges Assignments

The judges for International assignments will be selected using the T&T FIG Brevet [International assignment rubric](#).

The Selection Committees will name the judges, based on the recommendation of the Technical committee and the rank of the judges according to the [T&T FIG Brevet International assignment rubric](#).

The judges for the 2024 Indo-Pacific Championships team must meet the criteria outlined in the international assignment document located on the USA Gymnastics Trampoline and Tumbling website.

- Available for the entire duration of the event, including all mandatory training and competition
- Compliance with the USA Gymnastics [Safe Sport Policy](#), [Code of Ethical Conduct](#), and Trampoline & Tumbling Responsibilities Manual.
- Current Judge member in good standing with USA Gymnastics.
- Meet the Qualifications for Service outlined in the USA Gymnastics [Leadership Eligibility and Service policy](#).
