Statement of Principles

In 2025, USA Gymnastics will focus efforts and resources into international competitions through entering teams and individuals. These competitions have been chosen for reasons including but not limited to timing, competitive fields, ability to safely attend, international relations, and program / athlete development.

In order to provide the best chance to selected athletes to achieve their goals, and in order to retain a minimum competitive standard for USA Gymnastics T&T teams, smaller delegations than the maximum may be assigned to a specific event. This will be determined on a case-by-case basis, for reasons including but not limited to allocation of support personnel (medical, coaches, security, HoD etc.), safety considerations, timing of key domestic events, and prioritization of other relevant resources.

Athlete Assignment Principles

Athletes will be evaluated based on a combination of qualification scores, final scores, and placements over the 12 months prior to selection. Performances at key domestic competitions (specifically, the most recent Winter Classic, Elite Challenge, and USA Gymnastics Championships), as well as relevant international events (whether representing Team USA or otherwise approved by the Program Director), will be considered.

This evaluation will serve as a guideline only. The Selection Committee retains discretion to assign athletes to events based on their overall assessment and how the athlete assignments will align with the stated goals of Team USA for each specific event. These goals include, but are not limited to, developing and providing international opportunity to Senior National Team (SNT) and Junior National team (JNT) athletes, advancing Team USA athletes to finals, securing podium finishes, and strategic preparation for premier international competitions.

Coach Assignment Principles

Team coaches will be assigned by the Selection Committee for each event from among National Team Coordinators, personal coaches of assigned athletes, and other US coaches with international experience as needed. Assignments will be guided by the needs of the program and the stated goals for each event, ensuring the right support for both athlete development and team success.

To be considered, coaches must meet the following baseline criteria:

- **USA Gymnastics Membership:** Current Competitive Coach member in good standing.
- **Event Availability:** Available for the full duration of the event, including all mandatory travel, training, and competition. Coaches must express this availability via the [Coach's EOI Form](#).
- **Compliance:** Adherence to the USA Gymnastics Safe and Response Policy, Code of Ethical Conduct, and T&T Program Manual.
- **Qualifications for Service:** Fulfillment of the criteria outlined in the USA Gymnastics Leadership Eligibility and Service policy.

Additional factors, such as international experience, leadership ability, technical expertise, rapport with athletes, and effective communication skills, will also be considered to ensure the most qualified coaches are selected for each event.

2025 World Cup in Baku, AZE

Event Overview:

Maximum Team Size:

- Up to four (4) Senior Elite Men and four (4) Senior Elite Women for TRA.
- Up to four (4) Senior Elite Men and four (4) Senior Elite Women for TUM.
- Up to one (1) non-traveling alternate will be named in each gender and discipline.

Purpose of Event:

- The primary purpose of this event is to provide SNT athletes with opportunity to gain international competition experience, with an emphasis on (but not limited to) developing SNT athletes with limited history of international assignments/selection.

Funding:

- All assigned athletes will receive 100% funding for the event, covering travel, apparel, accommodations, meals, and competition expenses.

Timeframe:

- Team will be assigned November of 2024.
- Coaches' EOI due by November 25th, 2024

2025 World Cup in Riccione, ITA

Event Overview:

- **Location:** Riccione, ITA
- **Disciplines:** Trampoline (TRA), Double Mini Trampoline (DMT)

Maximum Team Size:

- Up to four (4) Senior Elite Men and four (4) Senior Elite Women for TRA.
- Up to four (4) Senior Elite Men and four (4) Senior Elite Women for DMT.
- Up to one (1) non-traveling alternate will be named in each gender and discipline.

Purpose of Event

- The goal for Team USA at the 2025 Riccione World Cup is to name top performing SNT athletes with a focus on advancing to finals and securing podium finishes. This event will provide a critical opportunity to prepare SNT athletes them for future premier competitions.

Funding:

- All assigned athletes will receive 100% funding for the event, covering travel, apparel, accommodations, meals, and competition expenses.

Timeframe:

- Team will be assigned following the 2025 Winter Classic.
- Coaches' EOI due by March 9th 2025

2025 Senior Pan American Championships

Event Overview:

- **Date:** May 16th-18th, 2025
- **Location:** San Salvador, ESA
- **Disciplines:** Trampoline (TRA)

Maximum Team Size:

- Up to four (4) Senior Elite Men and four (4) Senior Elite Women for TRA.
- Up to one (1) non-traveling alternate will be named in each gender and discipline.

Purpose of Event:

- The primary purpose of this event is to provide SNT athletes with opportunity to gain international competition experience, with an emphasis on (but not limited to) developing SNT athletes with limited history of international assignments/selection.

Funding:

- All assigned athletes will receive 100% funding for the event, covering travel, apparel, accommodations, meals, and competition expenses.

Timeframe:

- Teams will be assigned following the 2025 Winter Classic
- Coaches' EOI due by March 9th, 2025

- Up to four (4) Senior Elite Men and four (4) Senior Elite Women for TUM.
- Up to four (4) Senior Elite Men and four (4) Senior Elite Women for DMT.
- Up to one (1) non-traveling alternate will be named in each gender and discipline.

Purpose of Event

- TRA: The primary purpose of this event is to provide SNT athletes with opportunity to gain international competition experience, with an emphasis on (but not limited to) developing SNT athletes with limited history of international assignments/selection.
- TUM & DMT: The primary goal of the Coimbra World Cup is to provide World Games team members (competing athlete and alternate) with vital international experience in preparation for the World Games. Additional athletes, up to the maximum team size, will be assigned from top-performing SNT athletes, with a focus on advancing to finals and securing podium finishes.

Funding:

- All assigned athletes will receive 100% funding for the event, covering travel, apparel, accommodations, meals, and competition expenses.

Timeframe:

- Team will be named following the 2025 Elite Challenge
- Coaches' EOI due by May 10th, 2025

2025 Gymfest in Coimbra, POR

Event Overview:

- **Date:** July 5-6, 2025
- **Location:** Coimbra, POR
- **Disciplines:** Trampoline (TRA), Tumbling, (TUM), Double Mini Trampoline (DMT)

Maximum Team Size:

- Up to four (4) Junior Elite Men and four (4) Junior Elite Women for TRA.
- Up to four (4) Junior Elite Men and four (4) Junior Elite Women for TUM.
- Up to four (4) Junior Elite Men and four (4) Junior Elite Women for DMT.
- Up to one (1) non-traveling alternate will be named in each gender and discipline.

Purpose of Event

- The primary purpose of this event is to provide top performing Junior Elite athletes with opportunity to gain international competition experience, with an emphasis on developing JNT athletes.

Funding:

- All assigned athletes will be self-funded for this event.

Timeframe:

- Team will be named following the 2025 Elite Challenge
- Coaches' EOI due by May 10th, 2025

2025 World Cup in Varna, BUL

- **Location:** Varna, BUL
- **Disciplines:** Trampoline (TRA)

Maximum Team Size:

- Up to four (4) Senior Elite Men and four (4) Senior Elite Women for TRA.
- Up to one (1) non-traveling alternate will be named in each gender and discipline.

Purpose of Event

- To provide the selected World Championships Team with vital international experience in preparation for the World Championships.

Funding:

- All assigned athletes will receive 100% funding for the event, covering travel, apparel, accommodations, meals, and competition expenses.

Timeframe:

- Team will be named following the 2025 USA Gymnastics Championships
- Coaches' EOI due by June 15th, 2025

2025 World Cup in Antibes, FRA

- **Location:** Antibes, FRA
- **Disciplines:** Trampoline (TRA), Tumbling (TUM)

Maximum Team Size:

- Up to four (4) Senior Elite Men and four (4) Senior Elite Women for TRA.
- Up to four (4) Senior Elite Men and four (4) Senior Elite Women for TUM.
- Up to one (1) non-traveling alternate will be named in each gender and discipline.

Purpose of Event

- To provide the selected World Championships Team with vital international experience in preparation for the World Championships.

Funding:

- All assigned athletes will receive 100% funding for the event, covering travel, apparel, accommodations, meals, and competition expenses.

Timeframe:

- Team will be named following the 2025 USA Gymnastics Championships
- Coaches' EOI due by June 15th, 2025
