March 08 - 11-16 USA Team: In the 11-16 age category, Team USA had three (3) pair/groups - 2 Women's Groups & 1 Mixed Pair. Per the MAIA competition statues, a country may compete in 11-16 team competition with the sum of 2 Pairs and 1 Group or 1 Pair and 2 Groups. All pair/groups must compete in the 11-16 category with the sum of balance and dynamic routines determining the winner. With a total score of 116.450, Krissy Weidmaier, Ashley Hargis, and Chelcea Reigel (WG), Alexa Vitale, Samantha Larson, and Kelly Phillips (WG) and Ani Smith and Jake Kanavel (MXP) earned the 11-16 Team competition gold medal. Great job 11-16 athletes.

March 08 - Preliminaries: On Saturday, March 8, Team USA started the first, of two, days of competition. The USA squad demonstrated confidence, polish and a high level of difficulty on each of their preliminary routines. The 11-16 category competed a balance and dynamic routine with the highest sum of both routines qualifying the top pair/groups into finals. The final standings will be determined by the highest scoring routine on Sunday. Coaches will select the athlete's balance or dynamic routine to present to the panel of judges on Sunday. The Junior and Senior athletes competed their balance and dynamic routine with the highest sum of both routines qualifying the top athletes into finals. On Sunday, junior and senior athletes will present their combined routines with scores starting from zero.
