The ASC met following the 2019 Rhythmic Challenge and Invitational. Because there is such a large number of competitive Junior and Senior athletes, a strategic plan was established based on criteria that was results-based in order to make the international assignments.

Juniors: Two levels of international representation before the 2019 National Qualifier and these are the only events approved for participation:

1. FIG events open to a select group of junior athletes who are US citizens*:
 - a. Current Junior National Team members who competed in the 2019 Rhythmic Challenge with a minimum AA score of 50.00
 - b. The top 5 Level 10 gymnasts with a minimum 51.50 AA from the Rhythmic Challenge Invitational
 - c. Level 9 with a minimum 55.00 AA from Rhythmic Challenge Invitational
2. Officially-assigned FIG events: the top 5 National Team members and the top 5 Levels 10 juniors from the 2019 Rhythmic Challenge and Invitational, distributed amongst 3 international events

Seniors: Two levels of international representation before the 2019 National Qualifier and these are the only events approved for participation:

1. FIG events open to all senior individual athletes in the 2019 Rhythmic Challenge
2. Officially-assigned FIG events: top 6 seniors from the Rhythmic Challenge

Per the Rules and Policies, at least two senior athletes will verify at a later date and may be assigned should their performances and/or results be commensurate with those of top 6 seniors at the 2019 Rhythmic Challenge.
