1. Because Jessica Howard could not attend due to travel restrictions, the Committee welcomed Ava to her first IEC meeting as a newly elected Athlete Representative.
2. The IEC commended the organization of the Group Championships in conjunction with the Rhythmic Challenge this year.
3. Caroline informed the IEC that in 2011 Rhythmic, Acro and Trampoline will have a VISA Championships separate from Artistic, likely in July.
4. Per the direction of the RPC, the Committee discussed the number of qualifiers to the VISA Championships. For 2010 the numbers will remain as for 2009: 25 JR and 20 SR. Starting in 2011, the number will be determined yearly immediately following the Rhythmic Challenge.
5. The office will look into moving the Rhythmic Challenge to the end of February for 2011. In this case, as this year, early international assignments will be made at the January camp 2011.
