After the qualification for Elite and Level 10 places per the Rules and Policies, USA Gymnastics allows 60 additional places at the 2024 USA Gymnastics Championships.

The allocation of places between JR and SR gymnasts will be established in line with the overall percentages of Level 9+Level 10 JR vs SR gymnasts registered nationally.

These places are based on the combined AA rank order of Level 9 with Level 10, following the set places for Elite and Level 10 per the Rules and Policies and will compete as National JR and National SR at the Championships:

JR: 45
SR: 15

4. Tie Rule: When there is a tie in the final qualifying place for any of these rankings, ties will not be broken, and the total number advancing will be respected.

SC: Catherine
Vote: Approved All

The RPC confirms—by follow-up email, per the Rules and Policies, no Foreign Athletes participate in any session of the USA Gymnastics Championships.

Per the discussion of the RPC in December 2023, to allow all Regional Teams to count for the team ranking even in case of “force major” such as on-site injury or illness during the Championships, the top 10 scores from each apparatus for each Regional Team member by level, will count toward the Regional Team score.
