Following the Challenge, both JR and SR Group assignments are made for the first phase of the season.

1. JR Group

The Charter foresees this committee as the body to *approve the selection process for JR Group National Team*. A JR Group National Team can only be named at Championships; however, as this selection committee is responsible for Group selection, it should approve JR international assignments prior to Championships.

The JR Group of Burlo Gymnastics is approved to compete at Aphrodite Cup (GRE) and Shining Star (UZB).

2. SR Group

Per the Charter, the committee's role as it relates to international assignments: *Confirming recommendations for the Group Senior National Team and international assignments by the Head Coach per established criteria. The Head Coach determines the final line-up.*

Further to the above, Kameliya, as Head Coach, has worked with these training priorities as criteria:

1. Execution of Body Difficulties
2. Execution of Tosses: accuracy, consistency with accuracy, technique (arms and body positions)
3. Ability to execute the elements on the correct musical accents (demonstrate an understanding of the musical timing of elements with accents and musical phrases)
4. Reaction to an unexpected challenge: ability to think and react quickly under a pressure-based or unexpected situation and to make a performance decision in the best interest of the team
5. Artistic presentation: Ability to demonstrate (from the COP) "a union of strength and power with beauty, plasticity, and elegance in the movements."

Per those criteria, the same line-up from the two highest-scoring routine results during the Challenge has been recommended and approved for the first international events prior to Pan Am (Sofia World Cup, Baku World Cup, Portimao World Challenge Cup):

5 Ribbons: Goda, Kalina, Alaini, Greta, Anabella

3/2: Goda, Kalina, Alaini, Greta, Anastasia

In the Amsterdam Friendship Cup tournament, the line up: the same as above along with

5 Ribbons: Natalia, Liza, Kristina, Anastasia, Deanna

3/2: Natalia, Liza, Kristina, Anabella, Deanna (intent to compete as well with Lorelei in the same position as Challenge).

Those not competing the first World Cups will compete at the Classic and the Qualifier.
