The RPC members participated in discussions over the month on the topics of the landscape of national judging exams in relation to the testing capacities of the national office, FIG online exam timelines, etc; inquiries at national events; the number of qualification places for the SR and JR Classics.

The National/Brevet current judges' ratings will be extended until the FIG online Brevet exam which has a provisional timeframe of early Fall 2025 (per PAGU and FIG).

Given that the Brevet ratings of the previous cycle expire April 1, all Brevet judges from the previous cycle *who are not yet renewed for 2025-2028* will have a "national" rating until they pass the online exam with the requisite score established by FIG (or 45% for "national").
