### Development Committees Meeting Agenda

#### 1. Welcome

All attendees were asked to disclose any actual or potential conflicts of interest based on a review of the agenda.

- It was agreed that all committee members have conflicts of interest as a result of being athletes, coaches, judges and/or club owners and/or receiving compensation at times from the T&T program. Except in the case of items bulleted below, the individuals and committee share the view that members are able to act impartially and for the benefit of the program, and recusal is not necessitated for any other items.
- No Cols with today's agenda items were declared.

#### 2. Development Routines Presentation

The committee went over the power point presentation that will be shared with the membership at a roundtable. Each discipline was discussed and reviewed. It was recommended that when we produce the final routines that a live link showing each routine is included in the online documents. The committee will work to video the drills to help with the education of coaches.

#### 3. FIG Rules

Nuno encouraged the members of the committee to review the 2025-2029 FIG code of points and bring forward their recommendations of what they would like to include the development levels and what they feel would not work well in those levels.

Items discussed for inclusion in the 2025-2029 Development Code of Points included

- Order for finals - DP Recommend to stay with random order as it is now.
- Mixed Synchro – Allow
- Warmup penalty - From 0.3 to 0.2
- TUM
  - No more than 3 back fulls in a pass – Adopt
  - No more than 1 back full between two passes as skill 8 - Level 9, 10 & Open
  - New bonuses for Women & Men - Level 9, 10 & Open

- Y elements allowed in tumbling
- DMT
  - Maximum mark for 1 skill (8 Points) – Adopt
  - Levels 1-4 - Allow use of mounting aid such as incline, panel mat or springboard
    - Only Levels allowed to land on zone closer to Double Mini-Trampoline
    - Allow 1 Foot mounter (not needed to be at the same time) as long as both feet land in Mounter Zone
    - Allow maximum 2 jumps after mounter skill - 1.0 Point Penalty per jump
    - 3 jumps means Pass interruption after Skill 1
