Meeting called to order by Patti Conner at 1:30pm EST on Thursday February 18, 2021.

Program Committee Meeting Agenda

1. Olympic Games Selection Procedures

The committee discussed a suggestion to make the Olympic Games selection committee compliant with the incoming USOPC rules regarding 33% minimum athlete representation. It was noted that compliance with this rule is not yet a requirement, however it is seen as best practice.

It was agreed to add a second Athlete Rep to the Olympic Games selection committee. The additional Athlete Rep will be approved by the Athletes Council. The Athlete Reps will have one vote between them.

Motion to add a second Athlete Rep to the Olympic Games selection committee.

This change will be submitted to the USOPC for approval, and once approved, the selection procedures will be updated on the USAG website.

2. Sanctioned Event Medical Requirements Policy

The committee discussed several questions that have been raised following the implementation of this policy:

- Does the maximum number of athletes apply to open training? How would this work logistically when we don't mandate when athletes can time their sessions? It was agreed to add clarification that the rule applies to the equivalent number of equipment sets, but once both medical are busy reserve the right to stop the training session
- Does the maximum number of athletes apply athletes stretching and warming up? It was agreed to the maximum numbers does not include athletes stretching and warming up off equipment.
- Can there be crossover between the disciplines at multi-discipline events?
- Does the sole purpose of the practitioners have to be medical? TT's suggestion is that they

could have another role so long as they can leave the other role immediately when needed.

• Where do the practitioners have to be located at multi-discipline events? This is related to the crossover question.

Jacqui to draft changes to the policy and submit to medical for consideration.

3. Time of Flight

The committee discussed the need to include ToF for Elite mobility. The committee tabled the discussion regarding next cycle – either the mobility process will be amended to reflect the equipment available, or the ToF requirement will be amended if not required.

It was clarified that the Veriflite ToF machine is approved for domestic competitions.

4. Tiebreaker Rules for Virtual Meets

Standard tiebreaker rules will apply for virtual meets using the scores available. If scores are still tied then it will be called a tie.

This information will be added to virtual playbook.

The committee noted the need to review the tiebreaker rules for the new quad.

5. NGF Board

The committee discussed potential candidates to propose for the NGF Board.
