2. FIG Intercontinental Course

The committee discussed the needs of the program as a whole and what criteria should be used to consider possible candidates.

Motion that the following criteria be used to name the candidates for the 2024 Intercontinental Judges Course.

- Judges must be certified in all three disciplines
- Candidates must mainly serve as a judge to help aid in the education process over the coming months.
- Candidates must have the ratings and competition experience to be eligible to test up to a category 1 at the Intercontinental course.

The US has five allocated spots and one additional designated spot based on the category 1 rating held by Konstantin Gulishashvili.
