Motion that in keeping with the concept of adopting the new FIG rules. Horizontal Displacement be considered for use in mobility competitions after the Winter Classic where the process will be implemented for the first time.

Motion to adopt the new tiebreaker rules for all disciplines in the elite levels. With the exception, that trampoline will use the current rules until Horizontal displacement is added to our process.

Motion to adopt the warm up procedure for all elite levels that when competition equipment is available in an adjacent hall. Trampoline will have a one touch warm up for the qualification and final round.

Motion to remove the following rules form the JO CoP

- a) Taking significant steps (three or more or running or a major stop (longer than 3 seconds) in levels 1-3 1.0 pts
- b) Touching outside the outer lines of the tumbling track with any part of the body during the pass per occurrence. Levels 1-3 1.0 pts
- c) Taking steps or hops or running prior to the power hurdle 1.0 pts

- d) Not performing the power hurdle prior to the round off and begins from a stand 1.0 pts
- e) Running prior to a pass that begins from a stand 1.0 pts
- f) Not ending in a two foot landing for levels 1-5 and level 6 first pass. 0.5

Motion to remove the running warm up passes from the warm up from both tumbling and dmt.
