3. Visual cues on the track or runup in TUM and DMT

Discussion was held about adding the requirements for marking visual cues back into the CoP considering the safety of the athlete.

“Only tape or Velcro markings may be used as visible cues for athletes. These markings must be adhered to the track or run-up and must be removed before the next athlete competes. A coach may also place their foot on the track as a cue. No other objects or markings are allowed in the field of play as a visual cue.”
