Meeting called to order by Dante Hebert via email on Wednesday August 14, 2024.

1. Welcome

3. Tumbling/Double-Mini Tape and Velcro Markings

Discussion was held regarding tape or Velcro markings as visible cues for athletes on Tumbling and Double-Mini.



(Proposed) Rule 1.6.8 in the Tumbling Development Code of Points

Only tape or velcro markings may be used as visible cues for athletes. These markings must be adhered to the track or runup. A coach may also place their foot on the track as a cue. All unapproved objects must be removed from the field of play prior to the athlete being allowed to compete. Any approved markings from another athlete must be removed prior to the next athlete being allowed to start.

(Proposed) Rule 1.6.7 in the Double-Mini Development Code of Points

Only tape or velcro markings may be used as visible cues for athletes. These markings must be adhered to the run-up. All unapproved objects must be removed from the field of play prior to the athlete being allowed to compete. Any approved markings from another athlete must be removed prior to the next athlete being allowed to start.
