Additional tasks and time commitments may be necessary depending on committee needs, program cycles, and organizational priorities.

Time Commitment

- Virtual Meetings: 6-12 meetings per year (60-120 minutes each). Vary based on program and committee needs. *Anticipate more when new Quad rules and selection procedures are being developed.*
- In-Person Meeting: 2-3 per year (Often in conjunction with National Competitions)

Responsibilities

- Serve as the Chair of both the **Elite Committee** and the **Selection Committee**.
- Serve as a voting member of the **Trampoline & Tumbling Program Committee**, contributing to broader program discussions and alignment across committees.
- Lead and oversee all committee operations related to the elite program and international athlete selection processes.
- Organize, schedule, and facilitate all meetings for both committees, including preparation of agendas, coordination of discussion topics, and communication of action items and outcomes.
- Ensure compliance with the USA Gymnastics Rules & Policies as they relate to the elite program, as well as all approved selection procedures for international assignments and national team selection.
- Oversee and participate in the implementation and administration of athlete and coach selection procedures to help ensure fairness, transparency, and consistency throughout the selection process.
- Serve as the primary point of contact between the committees and USA Gymnastics leadership, staff, and other committees as needed.
- Guide committee discussions and decision-making regarding elite program structure, athlete development, qualification procedures, and international assignments.
- Collaborate with discipline representatives to ensure all disciplines are appropriately represented and considered in committee discussions and decisions.
- Review and contribute to updates involving elite rules, policies, qualification systems, and selection procedures.
- Support communication with the broader T&T community regarding elite program updates, procedures, and committee initiatives as appropriate.
- Ensure proper documentation of committee motions, recommendations, and voting outcomes.
- Ensure adherence to USA Gymnastics policies, including conflict of interest and confidentiality requirements.
- Act in the best interest of the athletes, programs, and long-term development of the Trampoline & Tumbling elite pathway.
