Meeting called to order via Zoom by Nuno Merino at 6:48PM PST on Monday, August 10th 2026

1. Welcome

All attendees were asked to disclose any actual or potential conflicts of interest based on a review of the agenda.

- It was agreed that all committee members have conflicts of interest as a result of being athletes, coaches, judges, and/or club owners and/or receiving compensation at times from the T&T program. Except in the case of any items noted below, the individuals and committee share the view that members are able to act impartially and for the benefit of the program, and recusal is not necessitated for any other items.

2. Community Proposal Review

The Development Committee reconvened to continue discussion of several community proposals and provide recommendations following the Program Committee's review to ensure alignment.

- **Level 8 DMT Minimum Difficulty:** The committee further reviewed concerns regarding the current minimum difficulty requirement and discussed potential approaches. The concerns regarding skill progression outcomes with the current minimum were noted and will be brought for consideration in the new rule cycle; no changes were recommended at this time.
- **Crash Landing:** The committee received an update regarding the decision to align the Developmental Program's crash-landing rules with the Elite/FIG standard. The committee also discussed the application of the rule to skills where an athlete may not be considered fully prepared for landing, including straddle jumps and rebounds. Further clarification and education will be provided as the rule is implemented.
- **DMT 2.0 Penalty:** The committee further reviewed a proposal to align DMT scoring with the 2.0 penalty currently used for incomplete tumbling routines. After reviewing the purpose and potential application of the rule, the committee determined that the current scoring structure should remain in place. The committee will continue to monitor the frequency and impact of the scenarios presented and may reconsider the proposal during the next rule cycle.
