3. 15-Minute Elite Warm Up

After using the 15-minute warm up option at 2025 Winter Classic, the committee discussed the pros/cons and potential improvements. The committee considered the possibility of implementing this warm-up format at Elite Challenge (dependent on multiple factors). The committee discussed wording to add to the Elite Code of Points.

Motion: To add the following verbiage to the Elite Code of Points, “15-minute warm per flight with no additional touches. All athletes must get the at least the minimum number of touches noted above that are required when a general warm up is offered. At the end of the 15 minutes if there are athletes who have not received the minimum number of touches, they will be allowed to continue the warmup time until the minimum number of touches are met.”
