The Athlete Selection Committee (ASC) met on October 1 and October 2, 2025, to determine the athlete assignments for the 2025 World Championships to be held in Jakarta, Indonesia.

The committee members disclosed no conflicts of interest.

Athletes may accept or decline assignments.

October 1, 2025

Annie opened the meeting by welcoming Charlene to the Athlete Selection Committee and introducing Jessie, who joined via Zoom as the athlete representative.

Per the 2025 World Championships Selection Procedures, Dulcy Caylor earned her automatic placement on the 2025 World Championships Team by winning the all-around competition on Day 1.

Annie confirmed that on Day 2, Athletes may be assigned between one and three events depending on competitive need.

The committee reviewed individual event assignments, and specific event plans were as follows:

- Skye Blakely: Bars and Beam
- Dulcy Caylor: Beam
- Jayla Hang: Vault and Beam
- Gabrielle Hardie: Bars
- Joscelyn Roberson: Vault and Beam
- Simone Rose: Bars
- Ashley Sullivan: Bars and Floor
- Leanne Wong: Vault and Beam

Preliminary event assignments were approved pending athlete notification.

The committee reviewed recent scores and performances, emphasizing the importance of considering historical results and consistency when making future athlete selections. 2025 notable achievements include:

- Results from the 2025 World Cups and the 2025 Pan American Championships
- Athletes' previous international success
- Past international performances will continue to inform selection evaluations.



The committee identified 2025 World Championship medal contenders. Each athlete's strengths, D-scores, and recent performance trends were reviewed.

October 2, 2025

The committee members disclosed no conflicts of interest.

The committee reviewed scores from the second day of competition, focusing on athlete performances across international and domestic events. The group evaluated potential finalists for the all-around and event competitions, noting that Leanne Wong demonstrated consistent results and medal potential, making her a strong candidate for consideration.

Floor and beam performances were reviewed in detail.

- Skye Blakely was recognized as the top performer on both bars (two-day total) and beam (day two).
- Jocelyn Roberson and Dulcy Caylor were identified as top single-day floor scorers.

The committee evaluated athletes for upcoming multi-event competitions, focusing on bars, beam, and floor. Skye Blakely was identified as the strongest contender for bars and beam, while Joscelyn Roberson and Ashlee Sullivan were top considerations for floor and vault. The team reviewed performances from the 2025 U.S. Classic and U.S. Championships to inform their decisions, noting Joscelyn's consistency.

The group emphasized the need to select athletes capable of contributing to multiple events rather than a specialist on a single apparatus.

The committee discussed overall team selection and performance results, with specific attention to floor routines. Jocelyn Roberson was identified as showing strong medal potential. Ashlee Sullivan's performance was acknowledged for all-around strength.

The committee reviewed the selection criteria for World Championship competitors. Charlene emphasized adherence to objective measures such as D-scores, competition results, and physical readiness under Section 5.2.

The group discussed replacement athlete selection, agreeing that two alternates may be considered.

Regarding replacement athletes - athlete readiness for the upcoming World Championships was discussed, with a focus on Jayla Hang and Ashlee Sullivan. Performances from the U.S. Classic, the U.S. Championships, and selection events were discussed. Jayla Hang's strong performances at the 2025 World Cups and her first-place all-around result at the Pan American Championships were acknowledged.

The committee finalized decisions regarding replacement athletes for the upcoming competition.
