SAFETY AND RESPONSE REPORTING

- Any adult under the jurisdiction of USA Gymnastics must report sexual misconduct to both the local authorities and the U.S. Center for SafeSport immediately upon becoming aware of such acts. The Center for SafeSport has exclusive jurisdiction to respond to and manage such reports. To make a report to the Center, go to <u>uscenterforsafesport.org/report-a-concern</u>.

SAFETY AND RESPONSE POLICY

- Every athlete has the right to train and compete safely, regardless of whether they are learning
 a basic skill or representing the United States on the international stage. The USA Gymnastics
 Safety and Response Policy provides a blueprint to reach that aim.
- The Policy outlines a three-pronged process to ensure the protection of our athletes and members. It mandates reporting by all Adult Participants, defines misconduct, and sets boundaries for interaction between Adult Participants and Minor Athletes through the Prevention Policies.
